This will be a highly collaborative initiative which will seek input from you via workshops, local meetings and online to develop recommendations for how these neighborhoods can capitalize on improved public transit, to attract new businesses and to provide expanded housing options with transit as a driver. The study period runs from August 2017 through July 2018.
